PEOPLE OF THE COVENANT

If there is one word that stands out in today's readings, it is "covenant." God's faithfulness and goodness serve as examples to us of how to live. Genesis tells the story of Noah and of God's covenant not only with all people, but with all of nature. Never will the cleansing waters of the flood bring their destructive power to all the earth again. The sign, the reminder to both God and nature, is the rainbow in the heavens.

The psalm reminds us of this compassion of God, and begs God to remember us, not because of our goodness, but because of God's goodness and fidelity to the promise. God shows us how to be good, not by decree, but by example.

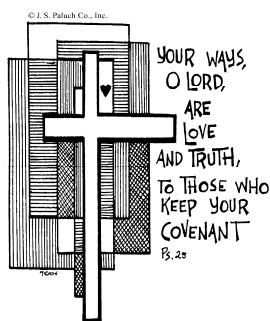

From the Desk of the Pastor...

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

"Your ways, O Lord, make known to me; teach me your paths. Guide me in your truth and teach me, for you are God my Savior". "In Jesus' 40 days of solitude in the wilderness, he confronts Satan and unmasks his temptations and conquers him. Lent is a time of combat! A spiritual combat against the spirit of evil. We place ourselves decisively on the path of Jesus, the road that leads to life. Jesus' path passes through the desert, the place where the voice of God and the voice of the tempter can be heard, where our destiny is truly played out, life or death. And how do we hear God's voice? We hear it in his Word. For this reason it is important to know Scripture, because otherwise we do not know how to react to snares of the evil One. So read the Gospel every day! Meditate on it for a little while, for 10 minutes. And also carry it with you in your pocket or your purse. The Lenten desert helps us to say "no" to worldliness, to the "idols". It helps us to make courageous choices in accordance with the Gospel and to strengthen solidarity with others." (Pope Francis)

How might I better rely on Scripture to follow the example of Jesus' courage to confront evil?



Each week we will take these reflections from our Holy Father, Pope Francis to help us on our Lenten journey.

As a Lenten commitment try to participate each Friday in our church, either in morning or evening Mass and in the Way of the Cross. Every Saturday after 4:00 pm you can come to church for reconciliation

through the sacrament of penance. This is a most appropriate time to pray more intensely and to reconcile with God, with our neighbor and with ourselves.

Queridos Hermanas y Hermanos en el Señor:

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Abstinence: Catholics 14 years and older are bound to abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday and all the Fridays of Lent. **Pregnant and nursing mothers and those with medical conditions are exempt.**

Fasting: By refraining from eating, we signify our oneness with the Lord, acknowledge our need for conversion, and give witness to our solidarity with those less fortunate. Catholics between 18 and 59 are also bound to Fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. Fasting means having only one full meal to maintain one's strength. Two smaller, meatless and penitential meals are permitted according to one's needs, but they should not together equal the one full meal. Eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Again, pregnant and nursing mothers and those with medical conditions are exempt.

The Code of Canon Law and our Bishops remind us of other works and means of doing penance: prayer, acts of self-denial, almsgiving and works of personal charity. Attending Mass daily, several times a week, praying the rosary, making the Way of the Cross, attending the parish Evening Prayer service, teaching the illiterate to read, reading to the blind, helping at a soup kitchen, visiting the sick and shut-ins and giving an overworked mother a break by baby-sitting—all of these can be even more meaningful and demanding than simply abstaining from meat on Friday.

REGULACIONES DE CUARESMA

Abstinencia: a partir de los católicos de 14 años o más están obligados a abstenerse de comer carne el miércoles de Ceniza y todos los viernes de Cuaresma. **Las madres embarazadas y lactantes y todas las personas con condiciones médicas están exentas.** Ayunar: al abstenernos de comer, expresamos nuestra unidad con el Señor, reconocemos nuestra necesidad de conversión y damos testimonio de nuestra solidaridad con los menos afortunados. **Los católicos entre 18 y 59** también están obligados a ayunar el Miércoles de Ceniza y el Viernes Santo. Ayunar significa tener solo una comida completa para sostenernos. Se permiten dos comidas más pequeñas, sin carne y penitenciales de acuerdo con las necesidades de cada uno, pero no deben ser iguales a una comida completa. No está permitido comer alimentos sólidos entre comidas.

El Código de Derecho Canónico y nuestros obispos nos recuerdan otras obras y medios para hacer penitencia: oración, actos de abnegación, limosnas y obras de caridad personal. Asistir a Misa todos los días, varias veces a la semana, rezar el rosario, hacer el Vía Crucis, leerle a los ciegos, ayudar en un comedor de beneficencia, visitar a los enfermos y dar a una madre con exceso de trabajo un descanso cuidando sus niños, todos estos pueden ser aún más significativos y exigentes que simplemente abstenerse de comer carne el viernes.

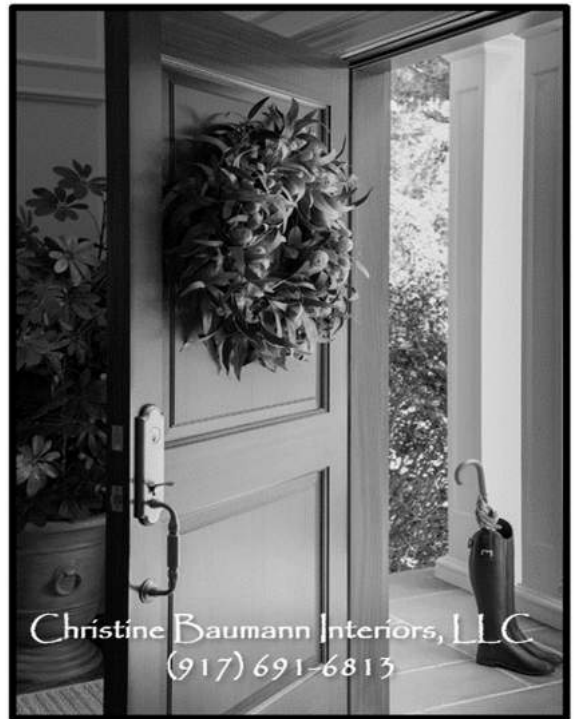
